PREANESTHETIC LABWORK

Even though dogs and cats look normal on the outside; they could have a serious problem on the inside. We can run a laboratory panel to check things like blood sugar, liver enzymes and kidney values. If the red blood cells are too low, the kidney values too high, or the liver is stressed, then placing them under anesthesia may jeopardize their life.

We can check your pets blood prior to anesthesia and surgery.

We suggest a chemistry panel, CBC, and electrolytes. The cost for this testing is **\$128.00**.

PAIN MEDICINE

Post surgical pain management can decrease recovery time after surgery. For most routine procedures 3 days of pain medicine is adequate. The pain medicine is dosed according to the weight of your pet. Approximate cost for dogs is **\$15.00 to \$20.00** and Cats **\$13.00 to \$16.00**. (Cat declaw surgery pricing includes pain medicine)

MICROCHIP

A microchip is a barcode chip that is inserted underneath the skin. When the chip is scanned, the pet can be traced to the owner. The cost of the microchip and injection is **\$46.50**. **You will need to register this chip.**

E-COLLAR

An E-Collar is placed around the head to prevent a pet from licking at a surgery site, wound or bandage. The cost of an E-Collar is **\$11.00**.
